

Join a clinical study investigating a treatment for alopecia areata



If you have moderate to severe alopecia areata, consider participating in a **clinical research study** of a potential treatment for the disease.

The purpose of this research study is to evaluate the safety and effectiveness of two investigational medications, in tablet form, or placebo, for alopecia areata. You may be qualify for participation if you:

- Are between 18 and 75 years old,
- Have moderate to severe alopecia areata,
- Have been experiencing hair loss for 7 years or less,
- Are willing to follow a treatment plan of scheduled study visits, lab tests and other study procedures for the duration of the study, up to 37 weeks, and
- Can avoid prolonged exposure to the sun or ultraviolet light during the study period.

For participants, all investigational medication (or inactive placebo), study-related tests and study doctor's visits will be provided at no cost for the duration of the study, up to 37 weeks. Participation is voluntary and you may withdraw at any time.
